Connect your RATIONAL cooking system now.





### Create a ConnectedCooking account.

 Register free of charge at app. connectedcooking.com or in the ConnectedCooking app.







## Check the software version of your cooking systems.

- Check this on the unit display under <u>Settings</u> > <u>Service</u> > <u>Installed software</u> version.
- If the software version is earlier than 16.0.24 (iCombi Pro) or 2.6.12 (iVario Pro), please perform a software update manually first\*.

### Connect the cooking system to the Internet.

- On the unit display, start the Network Wizard under <u>Settings > Network</u> settings > Start network wizard > Yes.
- > Choose the desired connection.
- ► LAN 🚠

Make sure that a LAN cable is plugged in. Confirm the selection and select "Later" for the proxy server, unless you want to configure it.

► WLAN 🕏

Select the appropriate network, enter the corresponding password and confirm it.

 DHCP is always activated by default.
 You can find more information on how to deactivate DHCP via the link in the QR code.

## Add cooking system to ConnectedCooking account.

 Follow the network wizard and confirm the support for registering with ConnectedCooking with Yes.

#### > Option 1

On the unit display, select Log in with my ConnectedCooking account.
Enter your e-mail address and password.
Assign a device name and confirm the entry.

#### > Option 2

On the unit display, select <u>QR code</u> <u>login</u>. Scan either the QR code in the ConnectedCooking app or enter the 9-digit activation code on your laptop. You can find more information about this in the video instructions (see QR code).

## Enable the necessary functions on your cooking system.

- Activate the following functions on the unit display under Settings > ConnectedCooking:
  - ► Automatically transfer HACCP data
  - ► Allow remote access (iCombi Pro only)
  - Download software updates automatically
- ► Automatic time zone synchronization
- > Restart your cooking system to finalise.

#### Tip: Invite Service Partner

Invite your RATIONAL Service Partner to your ConnectedCooking account and benefit from digital services.

#### Good to know: LAN or WiFi

For a stable connection, we recommend connecting via LAN cable.

WiFi signals can be disrupted by the high proportion of stainless steel in the kitchen, which results in poorer signal strength. It is recommended to place the WLAN router/access point directly in front of or above the cooking system on the ceiling, never behind the cooking system.



#### Note for your IT department

Some IT security policies require extra network ports to be enabled in the firewall.
